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# Action Taken Report (2023-24)

The institution aims to provide a wide range of facilities under one roof. To ensure continuous improvement and excellence, feedback is actively gathered from stakeholders, including employers, alumni, faculty, and students. Based on this feedback, appropriate actions are implemented to facilitate smooth operations and effectively address the suggestions provided. The AQAR for the academic session 2022-23 has been successfully submitted to NAAC and is accessible on the institution's website for stakeholders' reference and review.

### Alumni feedback

The valuable suggestions and inputs from students and alumni have consistently guided the college in achieving significant progress and establishing a distinct reputation within the academic community.

- The college continues to foster strong relationships with its distinguished alumni to inspire the students and enhance institutional pride. Dr. Dharampal Garg, Deputy Registrar of Punjabi University Patiala, and an esteemed alumnus of DAV College Bathinda, visited the college after being appointed as the Additional Controller of Examination. During his visit, Dr. Garg interacted with faculty members and students, sharing his experiences and motivating the younger generation. (19.12. 2023)
- In order to establish a formal alumni network to maintain consistent communication and collaboration and incorporate alumni feedback to further improve institutional activities and development plans Alumni Meet was organized (23.2.2024)
- The college acknowledges and celebrates the contributions of alumni like S. Jagroop Singh Gill, an esteemed alumnus and Member Legislative Assembly (MLA) from Bathinda. - In response to alumni feedback, the Faculty Room in the Student Centre has been thoughtfully converted into a College Guest House to provide a space for accommodating visiting guests, dignitaries, and alumni, ensuring a more welcoming and comfortable environment for their stay.
- Alumni are invited at regular intervals for motivational lectures, expert talks, etc. to communicate with the students and counsel them.

## Employers' Feedback

Considering the input from management across various organizations, the following measures have been implemented to benefit the students:





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• The Placement and Career Counselling Cell organizes placement drives and lectures for students so as to help them make informed choices related to the various career avenues and meet the potential employers.

### Students' Feedback

Students have conveyed their satisfaction with the overall college environment. Based on their suggestions and feedback, the institution has implemented the following measures and organized various activities:

- To help the new entrants acclimatize with the college faculty, culture, policies, academic structure, and build connections with their peers and seniors, induction programmes by various departments were organized in the new session.
- In response to the students' feedback and to provide comfortable and efficient space that
  promotes academic engagement and study, College Library has been renovated.
- Meeting the growing demands of technology led education, Computer Lab No.2 has been renovated.
- To provide students with good research facilities and equipment Physics, Botany and Zoology labs have been refurbished.





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- The Zoology Department Museum and Room No. 27 of the Zoology Lab have been refurbished to provide students with enhanced learning environment and improved facilities for practical sessions.
- To provide students with practical exposure and skill development opportunities, a dedicated herbarium room has been established in the Botany lab, along with the setup of vermicompost units and pits to promote sustainable practices and experiential learning.
- Based on students' feedback regarding infrastructural improvements, several measures have been implemented, including the construction of cemented slabs with granite tops in various lawns for seating, a sitting area outside the Student Centre cum Food Court, and a canopy in the Botanical Garden, enhancing both the functionality and aesthetics of the campus.
- For the convenience of students and to improve functionality of space tiles have been paved and girls parking area has been repaired.
- To promote health and fitness amongst students open gym has been constructed.
- To orient students towards serving the society and contribute for noble causes, various such activities are organized on the campus, like blood donation camp, plantation drive, cleanliness camp, etc.
