

## Action Taken Report

<b>Students Feedback</b>	
The students' identity was kept anonymous while getting the feedback proforma filled in order to evince an honest and fearless response from them. The received feedback was analysed in IQAC meeting. After thorough deliberations, following measures have been taken:	
<b><i>Student Centre cum Food Court</i></b>	In view of the complaints received from students regarding canteen facility, the old canteen has been dismantled and a new Student Centre cum Food Court (costing Rs. 45 lakh) has been constructed to provide with better quality food in a hygienic ambience.
<b><i>Infrastructure Maintenance</i></b>	Major repair of class rooms, washrooms, water tanks, labs etc. has been carried out during the last three years. Regular maintenance of buildings and other facilities is also taken care of.
<b><i>R.O. Facility</i></b>	In order to provide safe drinking water, RO system with a capacity of 400 lph has been installed in the college. Monitoring of TDS level and cleaning of water tanks is done regularly as per the maintenance schedule of OEM.
<b><i>New Classrooms</i></b>	To accommodate the increasing strength of the students, three new classrooms were constructed in the year 2014-15.
<b><i>Sports Facility</i></b>	Believing in the adage, "A Healthy Mind in a Healthy Body", the college strives to provide good sports facilities for the students. A lot of measures have been taken by the college in this direction. The playground has been renovated and is maintained properly. A Cricket Academy has also been started which coaches budding cricketers of the college and the city.
<b><i>24 Hour Power Supply</i></b>	Eco friendly Gen Sets of 85kW have been installed in the campus to ensure 24 hour power supply in the classrooms, labs and offices.
<b><i>Revamping Infrastructure</i></b>	To ensure cleanliness and smooth walkway, a new pavement of interlocking tiles in the entire campus has been constructed.
<b><i>Student –Teacher Interaction</i></b>	Teachers have been assigned as mentors for all classes to listen to the student grievances.
<b><i>Teaching Learning Outcome</i></b>	The paramount objective of the college is students' satisfaction. For this the quality of lectures is regularly monitored by IQAC. A feedback on teachers is also collected at regular intervals.
<b><i>Library Services</i></b>	Library has been automated.
<b>Employer Feedback</b>	
On the feedback received by the employers, following measures have been taken:	
<b><i>Practical Skills</i></b>	On the suggestion of the companies and the organizations visiting the campus, workshops and lectures to enhance the practical skills of the students are organized from time to time.

<b><i>Mental &amp; Physical Well Being</i></b>	In order to improve the concentration of the students, yoga day and annual athletic meet are organized regularly.
<b><i>Communication Skills</i></b>	Improving the communication skills of the students is the need of the hour in the current job market. Therefore, the college keeps on organizing various activities to involve maximum participation of students. These activities teach students to interact in a healthy manner with their peers as well as their seniors. It also enables them to work independently as well as in a group.
<b><i>Industrial Trips</i></b>	Students are taken on field visits, industrial trips and industrial training (wherever applicable) to provide hands on knowledge and acclimatize them with industrial environment
<b><i>Service to the Society</i></b>	The students are engaged in social activities at college level so that they can understand the concept of corporate social responsibility while working in the industry.
<b><i>Leadership Qualities</i></b>	Leadership qualities are inculcated in the students by being assigned a task which should be completed under their leadership with the optimum usage of the available resources. In order to teach leadership qualities and train them in interpersonal skills, the students are made a part of various committees.

<b><i>Student Centre cum Food Court</i></b>	Healthy eating habits have always been a concern for the parents. The parents thus welcomed the construction of Student Centre cum Food Court on the campus.
<b><i>Co-curricular Activities</i></b>	Working towards the enhancement of students personality, many academic and co-curricular activities are organized, which ensure maximum participation of students. These steps have been well taken by the students.
<b><i>Inculcating Moral Values</i></b>	The college strives to instill discipline and moral values amongst students.
